Action taken Report on Feedback on Curriculum

Academic Council, Chhattisgarh Dental College & Research Institute took feedback from various stakeholders namely: Teachers, Students, Alumina, Professional and Employers. The feedback mainly focused on the content and design of the curriculum. The report of the feedback was prepared in the form of Pie diagram and the suggestions received was tabulated. Point by point discussion of the suggestions was carried out in the Academic Council Committee meeting. The details of which are as follows:

S.No.	Suggestions Received from the Feedback	Decision/ Recommendation to the IQAC
1.	Introducing of MCQ in the examination pattern, so that the students are prepared for NEET & other examination.	Request letter to be sent to the Honorable Vice Chancellor of Pt. D.D.U.M.H.S. Ayush University of Chhattisgarh for the re-introduction of the MCQ type questions in the written examination of BDS program.
2.	Introduction of basic Research Methodology to encourage undergraduate students to take up research projects.	Basic research methodology is already taught in Public Health Dentistry. HODs should encourage the advanced learners from each batch to take up Research projects.
3.	Prosthodontics & Conservative Pre-clinics should be compulsorily done in phantom head or mannequin.	Proposal for the "Simulation Lab" with advanced mannequin has already been submitted to the Management.
4.	Oral Surgery final year students should be taught I.V. administration including practical on mannequin.	Proposal for the "Simulation Lab" with advanced mannequin has already been submitted to the Management.
5.	Introductory course on Magnification Assisted Dentistry & Digital dentistry can be included in BDS curriculum.	Recent Advances in all the courses are covered in didactic lectures. Dept. of Conservative Dentistry has Microscope for the treatment of patient. Dept. of Prosthodontics has conducted webinar on CAD-CAM. Also Dept. of Oral Medicine had conducted seminar on CBCT. More such CDE will be conducted in the future.
6.	Should incorporate Smart boards for teaching. Need to upgrade with advanced teaching aids and equipment	Proposal for the Smart board has already submitted to the Management



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7.	Train PG students in clinical photography and basics of computer	Workshop on Basics of Computer was conducted for the PG students. The same can be conducted for the UG students. Also, this will be upgraded to yearly workshop for newly admitted students. Similarly, workshop on Clinical photography can be conducted.
8.	University may introduce fellowship program in the subjects of Implant dentistry	The proposal for the same has already been submitted to the University. In the meantime, Interdepartmental Discussions of Implant cases should continue.
9.	University should set-up advanced research lab to provide research facilities like universal testing machine, scanning electron microscope.	MOU can be signed with the Engineering Institutes so that the students can easily get permission to use these instruments for Research purpose.
10.	Access to various online journals	E-Library is already functional. HODs to encourage staff and students to avail the facility regularly
11.	Medico - legal aspects can be introduced.	Forensic odontology is included in the syllabus of third BDS. Seminars and workshop should be arranged every year for UG & PG students
12.	Evidence based learning Should be Clinical based learning	All the Dept are already following Student centric learning. More topics should be taught through advanced Student centric learning rather than Didactic lectures.

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
