






## 2. The curriculum instructions were easy to follow.





I also felt that in the earlier period of the residency (first 3 months) there is lack of proper protocol with regards to research, thesis synopsis writing, and overall how to proceed with the studies and exams. This makes us feel utterly confused and we often have to spend time just to figure out how to make things work rather than actual working and studying. As a maxillofacial surgery resident I did feel a lack of optimal hospital training in my early days of residency, however, I feel this is because of the lack in our UG curriculum. I strongly believe that BDS curriculum should also focus on the hospital training in a little more depth so that residents are more prepared and

confident in medical settings. Although, it is in the course but its is not being implemented as well as it can be. Thank you.






#### 2. The curriculum instructions are easy to follow.






#### 4. The curriculum has relevance to clinical dentistry.








#### 2. The curriculum covers Modern/Advanced topics.







## Proposed Recommendations and Actions Taken based on Feedback

Institute has very limited role in designing and content of the Curriculum. Hence, Feedback on curriculum from various stakeholders should be used to identify the areas requiring greater elaboration.

- Curriculum enrichment is to be achieved through seminars, workshops and conferences.
- Cross-cutting issues relevant to gender, environment and sustainability, human values, health
  determinants, Right to Health and Professional Ethics will further be strengthened into the
  Curriculum by increasing the number of seminars and workshops on the topic.
- Value added course like Continuing Dental Education Program and workshop on current scenario, soft skill program, Practice management, aptitude program, personality development programs, yoga, meditation, time management, spiritual discourses etc should be continued and more topics are to be added. One Value-Added course on recent topics can be conducted by each department.
- HODs to encourage the faculty and students to attend and submit paper in the specialty conferences.
- Modern methods of teaching and learning should not only be continued but will also be encouraged
  to supplement alternative or traditional lectures for promoting active student participation. Casebased learning, evidence-based medicine, problem-based learning, simulation-based learning, elearning, peer assisted learning, observational learning, flipped classroom and team-based learning
  are some of the modern learning methodologies.
- Latest editions of Textbooks and Journals to be added in the Library.
- Strengthen the existing Mentorship Program to monitor the progress of the student and timely resolution of any difficulties faced by student.
- Internal Assessment Examination will be conducted as per the Academic Calendar. The syllabus
  for the same should be informed to the students in advance. Marks obtained by students should be
  reviewed and remedial classes should be organized as usual. Parents will be informed regarding
  student's attendance and other academic related activities.
- Co- Curricular activities should also be encouraged for the overall development of the student.
