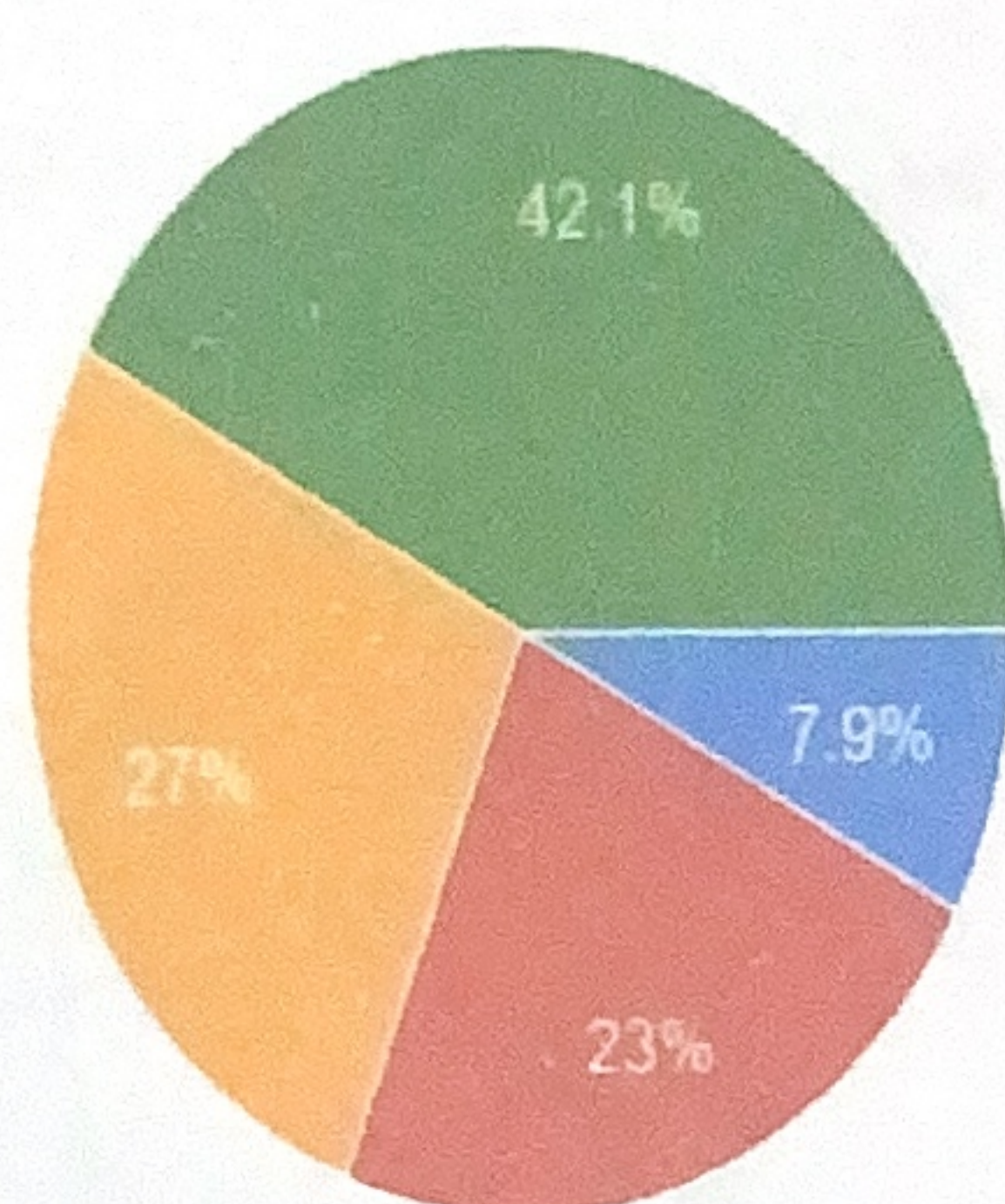
2022-2023

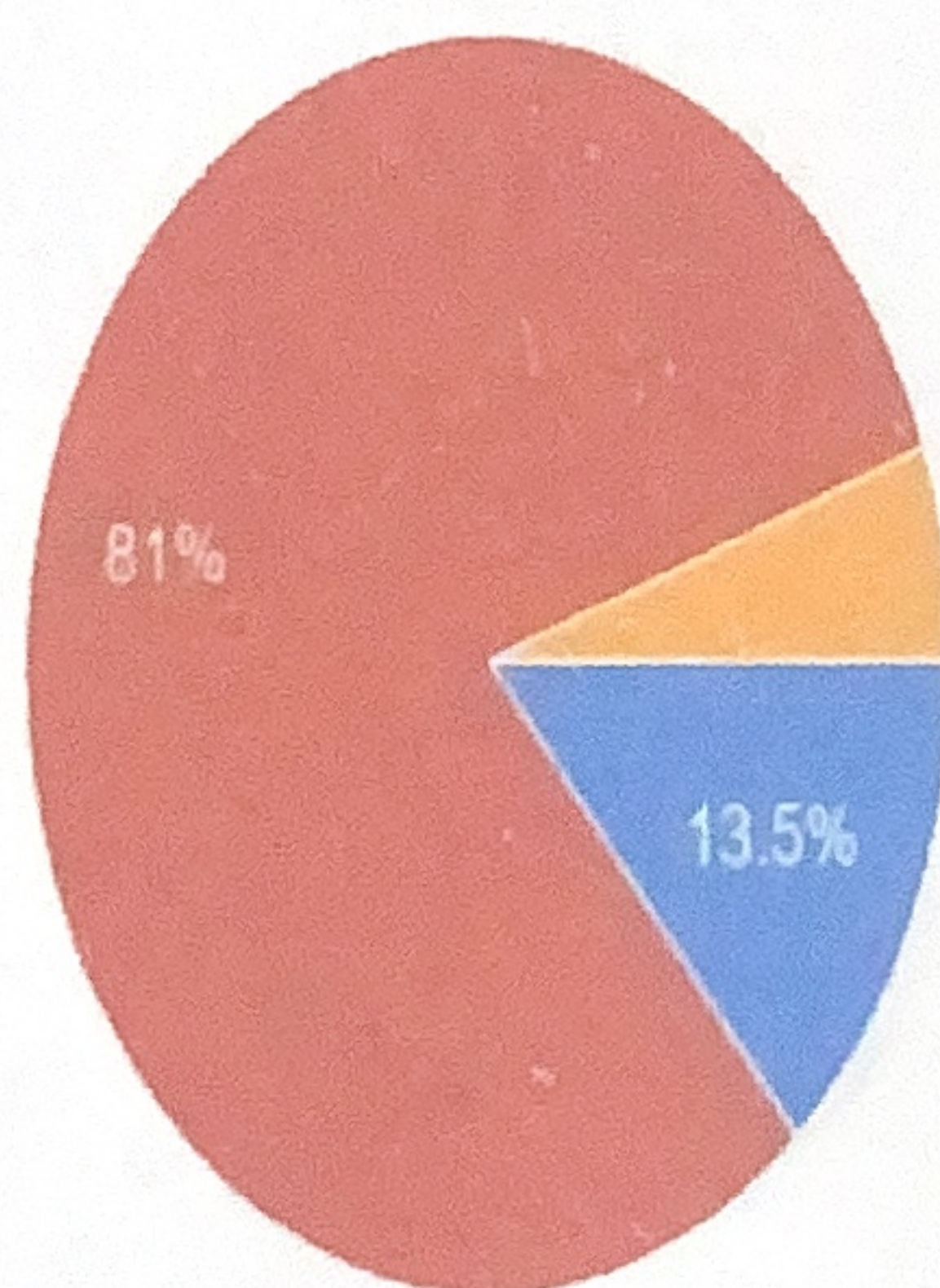

Proposed Recommendations and Actions Taken based on Feedback

Institute follows the guidelines laid down by Dental Council of India and the University. The Institute has very limited role in designing and content of the Curriculum.

- Feedback on curriculum is used to identify the areas requiring greater elaboration which can be achieved through seminars, workshops and conferences.
- Value added course like Continuing Dental Education Program and workshop on current scenario, soft skill program, Practice management, aptitude program, personality development programs, yoga, meditation, time management, spiritual discourses etc should be continued and more topics are to be added. One Value-Added course on recent topics can be conducted by each department.
- Proposal for Modern equipment's like Scanner, CAD – CAM, CBCT to be submitted to the management.
- Subscriptions of National & International Journals should continue.
- All the students to be encouraged to do Research other than the main dissertation and apply for funding through various agencies.
- HODs to encourage the faculty and students to attend and submit paper in the specialty conferences.
- Personal Counselling of students the existing Mentorship Program to continue.
- Internal Assessment Examination will be conducted as per the Academic Calendar. The syllabus for the same should be informed to the students in advance. Marks obtained by students should be reviewed and remedial classes should be organized as usual. Parents will be informed regarding student's attendance and other academic related activities.
- All department should maximally utilize ICT facilities and e-resources
- Co- Curricular activities should also be encouraged for the overall development of the student.

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
